Announcement of the result of voting on the revision of the Statutes

As Secretary-General of the IUAES, International Union of Anthropological and Ethnological Sciences, I am announcing the result of voting on the revision of the IUAES Statutes which was closed today. Each National Delegation to the Permanent Council had one vote, and copies of all votes cast by National Delegations were automatically sent to Vice-President Mugsy Spiegel, the Chair of the Committee for Installation of New Statutes. Backups of votes were also sent automatically to Vice-President John Gledhill.

The tally is as follows:

Yes	32
No	2
Abstention	3
total number of votes cast by National Delegations	37

(National Delegates of other countries did not vote, either because they chose not to or because they were unable to respond to the attempts by the secretariat to communicate with them.)

Amendments to the IUAES Statutes can be made by a two-thirds majority of votes cast. The proposed Statutes (attached) are therefore approved and the changes take effect immediately. This result of voting will be announced on the front page of the IUAES website.
